PROTECT OVERVIEW

PROTECT is a collaboration of three 501(c)3 nonprofits which are working together to reduce the vulnerability of children via identification and prevention education.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The following reflects a definition of essential functions for this job but does not restrict the tasks that may be assigned. Management may assign or reassign duties and responsibilities to this job at any time due to reasonable accommodation or other reasons.

PROTECT seeks a Regional Director to join our team and execute against our adoption strategy. In this role, the Regional Director will do the following:

- Meet County Superintendents of Education face to face - <http://ccsesa.org/members/directory/> and explain vision and program requirements
- Coordinate executive presentation to counties
- Conduct Readiness Assessment with each County Stakeholder group and HT Liaison.
- Identify and meet with County HT Liaison as well as Stakeholders to ensure high adoption rates of the program
- Establish regular communication with HT Liaison
- Work with Implementation Coordinators to train HT Liaison and Educators on systems
- Work with Implementation Coordinators to produce weekly regional progress report to 3Strands Global Foundation Executives and County Stakeholders
- Efficiently manage regional territory and county rollout of PROTECT
- Weekly PROTECT conference calls
- Set vision in each county for PROTECT rollout



Education and Experience

- 4 year college degree/Masters Preferred
- 1-3 years in field sales/marketing

- Excellent computer skills and in-depth knowledge of relevant software such as MS Office Suite
- Excellent communication skills and ability to use phone, email, and video conferencing to communicate with executives and administrators

Essential Functions

Essential functions of this position are approximately 30% relationship building, 50% drive program adoption and 20% technical support. Regional Director must be willing to travel 50-70% of the time depending on season, which will mostly be in California.
